This project comprises nearly 90,000 hectares of Amazonian rainforest in which commercial wood extraction is banned and the rich biodiversity of this region is allowed to thrive. Financing rainforest protection is the perfect way to offset carbon at scale while forging enduring relationships with the traditional stewards of this diverse ecosystem. Activities here will save an estimated 4 million tonnes of carbon over a 30 year lifespan, as well as:

- assisting local communities to develop alternative income sources through education;
- developing local jobs;
- providing access to finance; and
- incentivising the ongoing protection of local flora and fauna in a mega-diverse rainforest
